

Notice the repeat verses: [Matthew 24:5, 11; 23-24](#). It is interesting Jesus already said there would be false Christ's in v.5 and separates false prophets in v.11. I think it is likely there is a reason he repeats. Notice it comes after the abomination of desolation in V.15-22 he also puts false christ & false prophets together this time unlike in the earlier verses, and in v.26 combines it with the desert (*in essence it appears to me Jesus is referring to our day) and in verses 5 & 11 the Jews days. If so putting it all together you could have these events in order:

v.15-22 The abomination of desolation

v.23-24 the false christ's' appears with the false prophets

v.26 in the desert

Looking at the structure of [Matthew 24](#) I'm just musing, not saying it is going to happen that way but it seems like an interesting structure. God never wastes words or rambles. We will just have to wait for the scroll to unroll!
