

Overthrown – 10 Kings, 1 Kingdom

Daniel 11:41

41He shall enter also into the glorious land, and many countries shall be overthrown: but these shall escape out of his hand, even Edom, and Moab, and the chief of the children of Ammon.

5T81

The time is not far distant when the test will come to every soul. The mark of the beast will be urged upon us. Those who have step by step yielded to worldly demands and conformed to worldly customs will not find it a hard matter to yield to the powers that be, rather than subject themselves to derision, insult, threatened imprisonment, and death. The contest is between the commandments of God and the commandments of men. In this time the gold will be separated from the dross in the church. True godliness will be clearly distinguished from the appearance and tinsel of it. Many a star that we have admired for its brilliancy will then go out in darkness. Chaff like a cloud will be borne away on the wind, even from places where we see only floors of rich wheat. All who assume the ornaments of the sanctuary, but are not clothed with Christ's righteousness, will appear in the shame of their own nakedness. {5T 81.1}

2nd Chronicles 14:13

13And Asa and the people that were with him pursued them unto Gerar: and the Ethiopians were overthrown, that they could not recover themselves; for they were destroyed before the LORD, and before his host; and they carried away very much spoil.

11The house of the wicked shall be overthrown: but the tabernacle of the upright shall flourish.
7The wicked are overthrown, and are not: but the house of the righteous shall stand.

6Thy right hand, O LORD, is become glorious in power: thy right hand, O LORD, hath dashed in pieces the enemy.

7And in the greatness of thine excellency thou hast overthrown them that rose up against thee: thou sentest forth thy wrath, which consumed them as stubble.

Isaiah 5:22-24

22Woe unto them that are mighty to drink wine, and men of strength to mingle strong drink:

23Which justify the wicked for reward, and take away the righteousness of the righteous from him!

24Therefore as the fire devoureth the stubble, and the flame consumeth the chaff, so their root shall be as rottenness, and their blossom shall go up as dust: because they have cast away the law of the LORD of hosts, and despised the word of the Holy One of Israel.

Zephaniah 2:1-2

1Gather yourselves together, yea, gather together, O nation not desired;

2Before the decree bring forth, before the day pass as the chaff, before the fierce anger of the LORD come upon you, before the day of the LORD's anger come upon you.

The Decree

What are you doing, brethren, in the great work of preparation? Those who are uniting with the world are receiving the worldly mold and preparing for the mark of the beast. Those who are distrustful of self, who are humbling themselves before God and purifying their souls by obeying the truth these are receiving the heavenly mold and preparing for the seal of God in their foreheads. When the decree goes forth and the stamp is impressed, their character will remain pure and spotless for eternity. {5T 216.1}

Now is the time to prepare. The seal of God will never be placed upon the forehead of an impure man or woman. It will never be placed upon the forehead of the ambitious, world-loving man or woman. It will never be placed upon the forehead of men or women of false tongues or deceitful hearts. All who receive the seal must be without spot before God--candidates for heaven. Go forward, my brethren and sisters. I can only write briefly upon these points at this time, merely calling your attention to the necessity of preparation. Search the Scriptures for yourselves, that you may understand the fearful solemnity of the present hour. {5T 216.2}

17How oft is the candle of the wicked put out! and how oft cometh their destruction upon them! God distributeth sorrows in his anger.

18They are as stubble before the wind, and as chaff that the storm carrieth away.

Genesis 10:8-12 – God declares the end of Babylon from the beginning of Babylon – 10 Kingdoms

⁸And Cush begat Nimrod: he began to be a mighty one in the earth. ⁹He was a mighty hunter before the LORD: wherefore it is said, Even as Nimrod the mighty hunter before the LORD.

¹⁰And the beginning of his kingdom was **Babel**, and **Erech**, and **Accad**, and **Calneh**, in the land of **Shinar**. ¹¹Out of that land went forth **Asshur**, and builded **Nineveh**, and the city **Rehoboth**, and **Calah**, ¹²And **Resen** between Nineveh and Calah: the same is a great city.

¹And the whole earth was of one language, and of one speech. ⁴And they said, Go to, let us build us a **city** and a **tower**, whose top may reach unto heaven; and let us make us a name, lest we be scattered abroad upon the face of the whole earth. ⁵And the LORD came down to see the city and the tower, which the children of men builded. ⁶And the LORD said, Behold, **the people is one**, and they have all one language; and this they begin to do: and now nothing will be restrained from them, which they have imagined to do.

²⁶And when I have broken the staff of your bread, ten women shall bake your bread in one oven, and they shall deliver you your bread again by weight: and ye shall eat, and not be satisfied.

Ezekiel 29:3, 18-19 – The King of the North is Given the Land of Egypt

³Speak, and say, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I am against thee, Pharaoh king of **Egypt, the great dragon** that lieth in the midst of his rivers, which hath said, My river is mine own, and I have made it for myself.

¹⁸Son of man, Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon caused his army to serve a great service against Tyrus: every head was made bald, and every shoulder was peeled: yet had he no wages, nor his army, for Tyrus, for the service that he had served against it: ¹⁹Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, **I will give the land of Egypt unto Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon**; and he shall take her multitude, and take her spoil, and take her prey; and it shall be the wages for his army.

Ezekiel 30:6, 13-19, 10 ⁶Thus saith the LORD; They also that uphold Egypt shall fall; and the pride of her power shall come down: from the tower (**Migdol** H4024) of **Syene** shall they fall in it by the sword, saith the Lord GOD.

¹³Thus saith the Lord GOD; I will also destroy the idols, and I will cause their images to cease out of **Noph**; and there shall be no more a prince of the land of Egypt: and I will put a fear in the land of Egypt. ¹⁴And I will make **Pathros** desolate, and will set fire in **Zoan**, and will execute judgments in **No**. ¹⁵And I will pour my fury upon **Sin**, the strength of Egypt; and I will cut off the multitude of No. ¹⁷The young men of **Aven** and of **Pibeseth** shall fall by the sword: and these cities shall go into captivity. ¹⁸At **Tehaphnehes** also the day shall be darkened, when I shall break there the yokes of Egypt: and the pomp of her strength shall cease in her: as for her, a cloud shall cover her, and her daughters shall go into captivity. ¹⁹Thus will I execute judgments in Egypt: and they shall know that I am the LORD.

¹⁰**Thus saith the Lord GOD; I will also make the multitude of Egypt to cease by the hand of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon.** ¹¹He and his people with him, **the terrible of the nations, shall be brought to destroy the land: and they shall draw their swords against Egypt, and fill the land with the slain.**

¹Keep not thou silence, O God: hold not thy peace, and be not still, O God. ²For, lo, thine enemies make a tumult: and they that hate thee have lifted up **the head**. ³They have taken crafty counsel against thy people, and consulted against thy **hidden ones**. ⁴They have said, Come, and **let us cut them off from being a nation; that the name of Israel may be no more in remembrance**. ⁵For they have consulted together with **one consent**: they are **confederate** against thee: ⁶The tabernacles of **Edom**, and the **Ishmaelites**; of **Moab**, and the **Hagarenes**; ⁷**Gebal**, and **Ammon**, and **Amalek**; the **Philistines** with the inhabitants of **Tyre**; ⁸**Assur** also is joined with them: they have holpen the children of Lot. Selah. ⁹Do unto them as unto the Midianites; as to Sisera, as to Jabin, at the brook of Kison:
